

## **SPEA International Experience Scholar Application**

The School of Public and Environmental Affairs offers scholarships to incoming and current SPEA students. Students may apply for the following SPEA scholarship by submitting one application, a current resume and the required essay(s).

To be eligible for a SPEA Student Scholarship, students must be in good academic standing, both when you apply for the award and when you receive it.

Recipients of SPEA scholarships will be chosen by members of the SPEA Scholarship Committee, comprised of SPEA faculty and staff. All SPEA scholarship recipients are recognized at the SPEA scholarship luncheon in October.

Award amounts range from \$500 to \$2000 per year, per scholarship.

Scholarship deadline is March 1.

### **International Experience Scholar**

This scholarship supports students participating in an overseas study opportunity. To apply, you must be a SPEA graduate student in good academic standing who is participating in an upcoming SPEA overseas study experience. Recipients will be expected to document and share their experience with SPEA through means such as photography, blogging or journaling.

In a typed double-spaced essay of three pages or less, please discuss why you are participating in a SPEA overseas study program and how you anticipate this program will help you meet your academic and career goals.
