**MINOR IN SUSTAINABLE MANAGEMENT AND POLICY**

Any Indiana University students enrolled in a baccalaureate program, **except those pursuing a major in sustainable management and policy** may pursue the minor in sustainable management and policy. Students who successfully complete the requirements will have the minor conferred with their degree.

Students must declare their intentions to receive a minor by completing an **application**, which is available in online at [www.spea.iupui.edu](http://www.spea.iupui.edu). A **minimum GPA of 2.3** is required in courses taken specifically for the minor. At least **9 of the 15 credit hours** must be taken on the IUPUI campus.

SPEA Students earning a SPEA minor may double count two courses between their major and minor courses.
